- Typically a spot area is created using a light emitting spot bulb, providing a basking temperature of  $\sim 35^{\circ}\text{C}$ . This should be kept on for a minimum of 12 hours a day and switched off at night. The cool end should be maintained at  $\sim 20\text{-}25^{\circ}\text{C}$ .
- Background heat can be provided with room heating, a heat mat (on the back wall), a tubular heater or a ceramic bulb so that the overnight temperature does not drop below  $18\text{-}20^{\circ}\text{C}$ .
