Abstracts will be reviewed by a scientifixpert panel and will be selected for either oral or poster presentation based of the following criteria: 1) Elevance of the research to the conference theme 2) Scientific quality of the research approach, and Quality of the abstract writing Moreover, the panel will aim to achieve a balance in terms geographical representation, gender and level of seniority.
